Town of Cary Property Owner:

At the general election April 3, 2018, an advisory referendum passed asking the Town of Cary Board to contract with a garbage pick-up company to collect garbage in the Town of Cary. At the May 8 meeting, the Board voted to contract with Country Disposal to provide such service. Service will be provided for full-time residences.

Details of the contract are as follows:

- length of contract will be 2½ years to be reviewed at the end of December, 2020.
- service will begin July 9, 2018 with garbage to be collected every other week for all full-time residences. (Collection dates schedule on back of this letter.)
- garbage will be collected at the end of driveways. Garbage can be in up to four 30-gallon garbage cans or up to four 30-gallon bags. Garbage is to be placed out the evening before collection as truck routes will be completed early on pick-up days.
- if residents already own a loadable cart, it can be used. If they wish to purchase a cart, they are available from Country Disposal:
 - \$35 for a 64-gallon cart
 - \$50 for a 96-gallon cart
- Town of Cary will pay for service during the year and the total charge per residence will be added as a surcharge on tax bills at the end of the year.
- cost per month will be \$8 (\$96 annually). 2018 bill will be for one-half year pro-rated at \$48.
- fee will increase slightly only if diesel fuel exceeds \$4 per gallon or disposal fees increase.
- recycling contract remains as is.
