

Town of Cary Annual Meeting  
April 16, 2019 minutes unapproved

The annual meeting was opened by the Pledge of Allegiance at the Cary Town Hall at 7:00 p.m. There were 9 people present including the town board and grader man. Chairman Jim Patrick led the meeting. The minutes of the 2017 Annual Meeting were read. Jan Patrick made a motion to accept the minutes Dennis Brunner seconded. Motion passed.

The Annual Report for 2018 was read and discussed. Barbara Schmidt made a motion to accept the report. Marlene Neve seconded. Motion passed

Chairman reported that all tax money now goes to one bank. The tax collection is no longer co-mingled with the money for the operation of the Town of Cary. As the treasurer receives payment of taxes, those funds are deposited in a separate account for dispersal to the School District, the Technical School, the County and State. The share of taxes from the local levy is returned to the Town of Cary from the County in two payments. The first occurs in Feb-Mar and the second in August. The road aid is paid quarterly by the state. All money is deposited in the account we use for our day to day operations.

Chairman said that the clerk and treasurer are now using lap tops that are provided by the town and beginning to use the Excel program. This will make our budget and reporting process easier to implement and more transparent.

The Wisconsin Towns Association has a subsidiary membership called The Town Advocacy Council that lobbies for legislation that advocates for town government interests. The yearly cost is \$0.25 cents per resident. The town electors present voted to pay the fee, total cost will be about \$100 per year. Marlene Neve made a motion to pay the money to WI Town Association for joining TAC. Jan Patrick seconded. Motion passed.

Snow plow is still for sale and probably worth about \$1,500.

Chairman stated that the Cruz-air will probably have to be replaced this year. The board is looking into buying a different machine. The replacement cost will probably be about \$40 – 70 thousand.

Barbara Schmidt made a motion to donate \$200 to the Pittsville Historical Society, Marlene Neve seconded. Motion passed

The Chair provided a summary report of work performed and an explanation of the State Road Aid formula. The report is included separately for the website.

Dennis Brunner made a motion to adjourn, Dale Zawislan seconded. Motion passed.

Next year the meeting will be held April 14, 2020 at the Cary Town Hall at 7:00 p.m.
