

Town of Cary Monthly Meeting
April 16, 2019 approved

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 8:45 p.m. following the Annual Meeting by Chairman Jim Patrick. Those present were Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Dale Zawislan, Treasurer Barbara Schmidt, Clerk Patricia Lippert, Tim Ecker grader man. Also 2 other people present.

Dennis made a motion to approve the minutes, Dale seconded. Motion passed.

Dennis made a motion to approve the treasurer report, Dale seconded. Motion passed

Public Input: none

Old Business: Town Hall building received some damage from heavy snow. Some clips were torn from the roof, gutter damage, and ramp posts and railings. The township has a \$500 deductible on our insurance policy. The board did not think it would exceed that. Dennis will try to get a bid from Stickert Roofing. The board also discussed what they could do so this does not happen again.

Bridge Inspection charges Sept. bill was a partial charge from prior work done on the bridges.

Road work was done with the new carbide tipped blades on Lindsey Road. The carbide tips seem to destroy the potholes and keep them away longer. The blades were also used on Haycreek Road in the Town of Hiles. Dennis made a motion that \$600.00 of the \$1,200.00 made working in the Township of Hiles should be put in the machinery fund in Pioneer Bank. Dale seconded motion. Motion passed. The Board needs to define the fence area for the shop and get gates installed and fencing completed before the ground hardens up.

Excel program was started for the clerk, treasurer will start soon.

Equipment: Cruz Air is operational again, will need to use for culvert replacement when load limits are off.

Roads: Sign installation is complete. Culvert work scheduled will include reinstallation on Amelia and Progress roads.

Shoulder work with disc will begin as soon as the road limits are off. Road inspection will be Thursday May 9, 2019 starting at 8:00 a.m. Board will meet at the town hall. Tim should have ditches ready for brush cutting by mid-May. Schedule our 1st and 2nd pass on shoulder early June

MgCl application. The board discussed 1 or 2 tanks. Will bring the discussion back at the next meeting.
