

Town of Cary Monthly Meeting
May 13, 2019 unapproved

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Hall. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Patrick after the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Dale Zawislan, Treasurer Barbara Schmidt, Clerk Patricia Lippert, Tim Eckert grader man, also 3 taxpayers.

Meeting for Board of Review was opened. Due to the fact that the assessment roll is not complete at this time, the meeting was adjourned to a later date.

Dennis made a motion to approve the minutes. Dale seconded. Motion passed.

Dennis made a motion to approve the treasurer report, Dale seconded. Motion passed.

Public Input: Taxpayer asked about Building Permits in the Township.

Old Business: **Fence Enclosure** was discussed. A date will be set to work on the fence enclosure around the garages.

Preliminary Road Report: Chairman wrote up a report on road inspection. It was read at the meeting and discussed.

Propane contract for this year last winter was discussed.

Fuel Oil: **Jim not sure what you want here,**

Brush Cutting: JJ's Brush Cutting started May 14th to work on their 4th cutting in the township. They will do the 1st & 2nd pass in the beginning of June.

Dickson Lane: Discussed what should be done with the tree branches that are blocking the water flow in the ditch on Dickson Lane on the land that belongs to Wood County.

The work that needed to be done on **Cary Hiles Road Bridge** has been completed.

50/50 road program petition with Wood County was signed. No longer have to send money in ahead of time.

Ramp Repairs: Dennis made a motion to move the ramp on the town hall to the front of the building. Dale seconded. Motion passed. Cost of doing this will be checked out.

Equipment: The board discussed different options of what they could buy to replace the Cruz-Air.

Dale made a motion to buy a used **Stihl chain saw**, for use in the grader for \$150.00, Dennis seconded. Motion passed.

Dennis made a motion to buy a small **disc grinder** for the shop. Dale seconded. Motion passed.

Roads: All disc work is done on the roads.

State law says that any barricades that are left on the roads overnight must have lights on. Township will buy some.

MgCl. bids were opened from WI Salt Solutions. Price was \$1.03 for MgCl. and \$1.05 for calcium chloride. Dennis made a motion to buy 1 load of MgCl. and Dale seconded it. Motion passed

Resolution No. 003-2019 was signed. It stated that the amount of \$60.00 per hour for road work done for other townships would be deposited into our money market account at Pioneer Bank to defray the cost of machinery upkeep.

Dennis made a motion to pay bills, Dale seconded motion. Motion passed. Checks number 9213-9221 were written out for the amount of \$5,280.99

The invoice from Wood County Highway Dept. for thawing culverts on Cary Rock Road in the township was discussed. A letter will be written to the Highway Dept.

Mowing the lawn at the town hall was also discussed.

The next meeting will be June 11, 2019 at the Cary Town Hall.

Dennis made a motion to adjourn, Dale seconded it. Motion passed
