

TOWN OF CARY MONTHLY MEETING AUGUST 15, 2018 APPROVED

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Town Hall by Chairman Jim Patrick after the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Mark Yetter, Clerk Patricia Lippert, absent Treasurer Barb Schmidt. Also present grader man Tim Ecker and 2 members of the public. Mark made a motion to approve the minutes, Dennis seconded, motion passed. Mark made a motion to approve the treasurer report and Dennis seconded. Motion passed.

Public Input: none

Old Business: New road signs were ordered for Steffek Lindsey corner plus reflectivity stickers installation. The old signs were stolen. Wis. Transportation Bulletin No. 7 says we have to keep when and where new signs are installed.

6288 Lindsey Road culvert and ditching work is completed.

Wisconsin Salt Solutions was written a letter of thanks for the great job the driver did on spreading MgCL on the township roads this year.

Steps & ramps on town hall are done and looking good. Roofing repairs on main garage have been started. Landscape dirt was put on both sides of the town hall

Shredder for the township will be bought from Wal-Mart. It is an Aurora and can do 12 sheets at a time. Price about \$50.

MgCl for the taxpayers cannot be done unless they are billed by the company.

Propane Contract from Provision was signed and prepaid. Price was \$1.24 per gallon for 800 gallons. Price is good until August 31, 2018.

Fencing for the town hall will not be done until we get some rain, might have to wait until spring. Legal requirements from state states will be followed in the fencing.

Anyone wishing to buy **garbage carts** should call the chairman. He has some for \$35 & \$50.

Mark made a motion and Dennis second, motion passed to approve the **Wood County WTA unit by-laws**. The \$25 membership has been paid already.

No reply has been received from the Town of Wood in regard to Border Roads, and ditch filling on property on East Lane.

Equipment: Truck Repairs brake froze V&H repaired. Seal damaged when returned. Tim took back in, got work done on V & H warranty. Thank you V & H

Grader Repair: Have spare belts available. Bearing replaced now included in lube work.

Roads: Road Maintenance that was discussed at Road Inspection will be done for Dabrowski, Johnson, Steffek & Dickson on the turnarounds. Also gravel will be done on Lindsey and a lift on north Johnson which will be Halder gravel. Gravel will also be done on North Yetter.

New Business: Treasurer requested that the October meeting be changed to Monday the 8th, rather than Tuesday the 9th. Board agreed

Chairman picked up 5 TV monitors that were found in the ditch on Johnson Road. They were taken into Marshfield, & cost the township \$95.

Chairman is looking into different ways the township can handle building permits.

Wild Parsnips was discussed.

Tim, grader man pulled a culvert out of Amelia Road, weighed about 4 thousand pounds. He took it to 1ST Choice Recycling LLC in Spencer and received \$345 for it.

Dennis made a motion to pay bills, Mark seconded. Checks written out were #9059-9077 for the amount of \$8,971.79
