

Town of Cary Monthly Meeting
May 14, 2019 approved

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Hall. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Patrick after the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Dale Zawislan, Treasurer Barbara Schmidt, Clerk Patricia Lippert, Tim Eckert grader man, also 3 taxpayers.

Meeting for Board of Review was opened. Assessor notified us assessment roll is not complete at this time. The assessor asked for the meeting to be adjourned to a later date. Open Book and Board of Review will be rescheduled for late July or early August timeframe.

Dennis made a motion to approve the minutes, Dale seconded, motion passed.
Dennis made a motion to approve the treasurer report, Dale seconded, motion passed.

Public Input: Taxpayer asked about Building Permits in the Township.

Old Business: Fence Enclosure was discussed. A motion to place a set of gates to allow entry from Accola property to continue to use current driveway was made. Motion died for lack of a second. A date will be set to work on the fence enclosure around the garages. Gates will be installed to control entry at the north end between the buildings and also to the west side of the shop to control entry from Accola road.

Preliminary Road Report: Chairman wrote a report on road inspection. It was read at the meeting and discussed.

Propane contract for this year last winter was discussed. Alternate choices for vendor were noted. LP contracts are usually available by August.

Diesel Fuel: A comparison of fuel consumption from 2016, 2017, and 2018 confirmed our suspicion of fuel theft during 2018. We purchased nearly 600 more gallons of fuel in 2018 without a corresponding increase in the number of hours our equipment was running. Lock was changed and security fence will be installed along with other measures as necessary.

Brush Cutting: JNJ's Brush Cutting started May 14th on the 4th pass, also referred to as the outside pass. This cut is usually performed at about 5-6 year intervals in our town. They will begin the 1st & 2nd pass in early June.

Dickson Lane: Discussion on clearing the ditch of tree branches that are blocking the water flow in the ditch on Dickson Lane on the land that belongs to Wood County.

Ramp Repairs: The snow damage to the ramp for handicapped access was discussed. Dennis made a motion to move the ramp to the front of the building. Dale seconded. Motion passed. Estimated cost of this will determine if bids will be let.

Equipment: The board discussed different options of what they could buy to replace the Cruz-Air.

Dale made a motion to buy a used **Stihl chain saw** for \$150 for use in the grader. Dennis seconded, motion passed.

Dennis made a motion to buy a small **disc grinder** for the shop. Dale seconded, motion passed

Roads: All disc work is done on the roads.

Town of Cary will purchase some barricade lights to meet state code, State law requires that any barricades left on the roads overnight must have lights.

New Tiger boards have been installed on Cary Hiles/South Townline and Yetter Rd bridges.

50/50 road program petition with Wood County was signed. No longer have to send money in ahead of time.

MgCl. Discussion was held on amount of MgCl to place on roads this year. One vendor has submitted a bid. Dennis made a motion to buy 1 load of MgCl. and Dale seconded, motion passed. The choice of vendor has not been made. Another vendor may be available. Chairman will check on additional vendors and place order with vendor whose price and service is most favorable for the town.

Resolution No. 003-2019 was signed. It states that the amount of \$60 per hour for road work done for other townships, will be deposited into our money market account at Pioneer Bank to defray the cost of machinery upkeep. Our current rate for grader work is \$120 per hour.

Dennis made a motion to pay bills, Dale seconded, motion passed. Checks number 9213-9221 were written out for \$5,280.99

The invoice from Wood County Highway Dept. for thawing culverts on Cary Rock Road in the township was discussed. The bill is being held pending a discussion with the Wood County Highway Department.

Mowing the lawn at the town hall was also discussed. Chairman will contact people who did work last year.

The next meeting will be June 11, 2019 at the Cary Town Hall.

Dennis made a motion to adjourn, Dale seconded, motion passed.

Meeting ended at 10:00 p.m.
