

Town of Cary Monthly Board Meeting September 11, 2017

The regular monthly meeting of the Cary Town Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m., at the Cary Town Hall by Chairman Jim Patrick after the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Mark Yetter, Treasurer Barb Schmidt, Clerk Pat Lippert, grader man Tim Ecker and 4 tax payers.

Mark made a motion to accept the minutes and Dennis 2nd it. Motion passed

Dennis made a motion and Mark 2nd it to approve the Treasurer report. Motion passed

OLD Business:

Web-Site Update: Nancy Young, citizen volunteer reported that she created a domain for the township at www.townofcarywis.org. This will be the township website. Dennis made a motion and Mark 2nd it to approve the funding for the web-site. It was also approved that we can see about 2 year contract which would be cheaper.

Garbage Pick-Up Jan Patrick reported that the committee on garbage pick-up will have prices by October meeting so it can be used for the budget.

A taxpayer that his fire # could not be seen was found and put out where it could be seen.

Equipment:

1. Dennis made a motion to purchase this year a Diamond Mower for the price of \$6,288. plus freight of \$149. Delivery date will be April 2018. Have to pay for grader mount separately.

2. Laser Level: Spectra LL300N, which would be used to grade ditches properly, so water flow good was discussed. Mark said they could use his.

3. Tires on grader are worn. Mark thought to check out prices before they purchase any.

Roads: 1. Culvert installed on Johnson Road where the beaver problem was.

2. Sparks road ditch on south and north sides needs to be cleaned.

3. Scheduled for spring is calling Farner's for a cost estimate for 2 miles of blacktopping maintenance on Cary Rock & Steffek Road.

4. It was decided that 2 cuttings will be done on the roads this fall. Mark will call JJ Brush Cutting Service.

5. Load of breaker rock was delivered to town hall, to be used for ditches.

6. Because a change was made by the state in regard to road signs new ones need to be gotten for Steffek & Lindsey Road, Board said yes.

7. Discussed getting culverts and where the prices would be the cheapest.

New Business: 1. Mark made a motion and Dennis 2nd it to adopt "Ordinance 001-2017 TO ESTABLISHED REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW AND REPLACEMENTS DRIVEWAYS AND CULVERTS". The ordinance was signed and will be posted in the Pittsville Record and in all boxes in township.

2. Discussed buying land in township.

3. A board members will attend the Recycling Meeting at the Hiles Town Hall on Sept. 18,. 4. Jim Patrick will attend the WTA Convention on October 8-10.

Mark made a motion to pay bills and Dennis 2nd it. Checks written out where # 8880-8900 for the amount of \$16,745.56
