

TOWN OF CARY REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING,

**June 11, 2018 approved**

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Town Hall by Chairman by Jim Patrick after the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Mark Yetter, Treasurer Barb Schmidt, Clerk Patricia Lippert, and 2 members of the public.

Dennis made a motion to approve the minutes, Mark seconded, motion passed.

Mark made a motion to approve the treasurer report, Dennis seconded, motion passed.

**Public Input:** A resident wanted to know why the board decided to only put 1 load of Magnesium Chloride on the town roads this year. The board explained why.

**Old Business:** Chairman stated that he had received some thank you calls in regard to the referendum for garbage pick-up for the Town of Cary. The board wishes to thank the citizens who did this project. They are Jan Patrick, Lonnie Zellner, Joe Regenold, & Barbara Schmidt  
Dennis made a motion to thank them and Mark seconded, motion passed.

**Border roads,** The board received a letter from Town of Wood stating their ideas on the bordering roads of East Lane and Turner. Board discussed the letter from the Town of Wood, and the situation is still under discussion.

**Gravel prices** The board discussed the prices for gravel and will be contacting local vendors as needed

**Steffek & Cary Rock** An information request was made to Fahrner Asphalt Sealers to see when they would be doing the work on the roads.

Tim did the grading on the Town of Hiles Roads.

**Emergency Government** from Wood County sent a set of information that the Town would need to file for requesting reimbursement in the event of emergency work on the roads in the township.

**Wolf Road,** Oakdale Electric has finished the electrical work they were doing there. The ditch will require some repair work. Chairman will write them a letter asking them to repair it.

The township received an e-mail from the assessor in regard to when he would have the information ready for the **Board of Review.**

**Equipment:** Vantage Mechanical of Pittsville made a disk attachment for the disk mower.

Diamond Mower reimbursed the town for that charge.

Used compressor was sold

**Road Inspection:** The board read thru and discussed the road inspection sheet. They discussed where gravel would be put according to the road inspection sheet. Summer work on roads and culverts has been approved.

The board discussed Pelot land and ditching request. The town board will send a letter.

Chairman has requested Kafka schedule Mg CI application before the end of June.

Grading on roads is going well. May do additional passes with disk if rains come.

**Johnson Road:** Tim and Jim worked again on cleaning out the end of culverts where the beavers are plugging them up.

They will spot gravel on Yetter Road. The north end will need loads to help fill holes.

**Turnaround West end of Stefeck Road.** Correspondence was read and a letter was written in reply.

Someone noticed that the County trucks were using Cary Rock Rd, board will check as this is a posted Class B road

The Board also discussed culverts on Sparks and Lindsey Road. Letter will be sent.

**New Business:** Resolution No. 002-2018 was signed in regard to a fourth signature may be used for signing checks in an emergency.

New locks were put on the towns garages.

Mowing the town lawn and week whacking was discussed. Dennis will talk to the person that did it and see if he wants to keep on doing it. Price for doing the lawn and weed whacking was also discussed.

Building a fence by the town buildings was also discussed. Dennis said he has fence posts that he would sell for \$1.50 apiece

Dennis made a motion to go into closed session Sec, 19.85 (1) (c) Employee evaluation, Mark seconded. Motion passed. Roll call was taken, Jim Patrick, Chairman, Dennis Brunner and Mark Yetter supervisors, approved going into closed session for employee evaluation. The board went into closed session. Dennis made a motion to adjourn closed session, Mark seconded, all board members approved. The closed session was adjourned. Motion made by Mark to reconvene from close session. Dennis seconded. Motion passed

Mark Yetter made a motion that Equipment Operator and Maintenance position receives an hourly rate of \$18 for operating the equipment & maintenance of equipment.

Dennis Brunner seconded. Motion passed. Common labor will stay the same at \$14 an hour.

Dennis made a motion to pay bills and Mark seconded. Motion passed. Checks written out were #9032-9044 for the amount of \$8,587.81.

Next meeting will be July 10, 2018 at the Cary Town Hall at 7:00 p.m.

Mark made a motion to adjourn and Dennis seconded. Motion passed.
