Budget Meeting & Regular Meeting November 14, 2017

The meetings began with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Town Hall, Those present was chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Mark Yetter, Treasurer Barb Schmidt, Clerk Pat Lippert, grader man Tim Ecker, plus 5 residents.

Public Hearing on the proposed 2018 budget was started. Chairman stated that the Fire Protection and Ambulance charges went up this year. The levy was raised to \$105,492.00 which was the amount we could increase per state. That income did not cover the increase on Fire & Ambulance. If necessary the board will ask for an increase in levy next year if costs exceed revenue. During the Special Meeting of electors, Lonnie Zellner made a motion to adopt the 2017 levy to be paid in 2018. Al Gansch 2nd the motion. Motion was voted on by raise of hands. Motion passed.

The Town Board then discussed the budget. Mark made a motion to accept it and Dennis 2nd it, Motion Passed. The regular monthly meeting began. Mark made a motion to approve the minutes and Dennis 2nd it. Motion passed. Mark made a motion to approve the treasurer report and Dennis 2nd Motion passed.

Garbage Pick Up The committee working on garbage pick-up passed out Resolution 003--2017 authorizing a referendum regarding garbage pick-up for all permanent residents of the Town of Cary. Culverts: New culverts installed on Cook Road and Steffeck.

Recycling Board: Tire drive completed

Equipment 2 tires new and 2 used tires were purchased and installed on the grader for the price of \$3,794.80 from Schierl Tires.

Diamond Mower: need to send end bit to Diamond Mower to make mount for the disc.

Roads: Fall cutting looks good. They had to lift mower to avoid trees in ditches.

Discussed grading on Sparks Road.

Culvert: List of culverts needed next year was made. Also the culvert on Johnson Road that is cement (that the beavers plug regularly) will be replaced.

New Business: The legal layout of the town's property was used to determine where the boundaries are. Will contract the surveyor to finish up what the board needs to know.

New Printer Clerk : Board Ok the purchase of Work-Force Pro printer for clerk to use for towns work.

Resolution Resolution #002-2017 was passed to clarify handling of over/under payment by \$1.00 or less for the treasurer. Mark made a motion and Dennis 2nd it. Motion passed.

Chairman will place the order for culverts.

Chairman explained the e-mail he got from Emergency Government in regard to the flooding of Oct. 2016 in the township.

Dennis made a motion to pay bills Mark 2nd it. Checks written out where #8909-8926 for the amount of \$18,219.34 .Next meeting will be Dec. 12th beginning at 7:a.m. Meeting ended at 9:00 p.m.
