

Town of Cary Monthly Board Meeting September 11, 2018 approved

The regular meeting of the Town of Cary Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Cary Town Hall by Chairman Jim Patrick after the Pledge of Allegiance. Those present were Chairman Jim Patrick, Supervisors Dennis Brunner, Mark Yetter Pat Lippert Clerk, and Treasurer Barb Schmidt. Also grader man Tim Ecker. Dennis made a motion to accept the minutes with corrections. Mark seconded, motion passed. Mark made a motion to accept the treasurer report. Dennis seconded, motion passed.

Old Business: Dennis stated that he talked to Pro-Vision and they will give us the summer fill at \$1.09.

The stickers that we ordered from **Lang Enterprises** have arrived. Current state law requires all traffic signs in township have to have stickers on stating when the signs were put up in the township.

East Lane: The landowner removed fill he had placed in ditch to now allow drainage without flooding road. Letter sent to Laddick and Dupee Construction in regard to bids for gravel. It was also explained to Dupee Construction why the township could not order MgCl application for him. Sometime this week 2 inch lift will be put on the N Lindsey Road. North Johnson, 1 inch lift of Halder gravel was put on. Stopped at hilltop. Graveling to be done yet is Yetter, and patching Sparks.

Wolf Road, **Oakdale Electric** should have the ditch work completed by September 11 meeting date.

Work has been completed on shop roof.

No candidates for cleaning the town hall. Document shredder has been purchased.

The work is finished on the steps and ramp of the town hall. Mark made a motion and Dennis seconded to pay Tim Ecker \$275. more than the price he quoted in the bid, because the work took longer than he thought it would. Board had originally allowed for up to a 10% over run on the bid. Motion passed

Equipment: Filters have been purchased for grader.

Roads: Fahrner will do repairs on Steffek and Cary Rock in mid-September. The turn arounds on Steffek, Dabrowski, Johnson and Dickson Lane are done. Culvert was replaced and relocated to avoid landowner flooding on Amelia Road.

The board talked about the difference of black topping and chip sealing. It was stated that when using chip sealing it has to be over rock not Halder gravel. Discussed getting Scott Construction to speak at a meeting.

New Business: Discussed fall cutting, also building permits required by state.

If possible Denny and Mark will attend the meeting on Sept. 17th for Southwest County Recycling Board. Mark made a motion to buy a \$50. garbage bin to be put at the town hall for use . Dennis seconded. Motion passed. Jim will take care of notifying the garbage collection vendor.

Clerk asked to attend 1 day of the WTA Convention for Clerk Training on Oct 16, 2018. Treasurer asked permission to attend the Fall Town Workshop at Warrens Sept 25th. Board said yes to both.

Budget Resolution No. 004-2018 for the amount of \$4,535.00 for the new steps and ramp for the Town Hall was adopted. Mark made the motion and Dennis seconded. Motion passed.

Population in the township is now 418 compared to 2010 which was then 424 according to the Demographic Service Center in Madison.

Clerk asked permission to order sheets for writing bills out.

Mark made a motion to pay bills. Dennis seconded. Motion passed. Checks written out were #9078 to 9096 for the amount of \$21,794.51
