Culvert Sale Policy Effective July 14, 2020

Sale of culverts for Town of Cary property owners.

Culverts may be purchased from the Town of Cary stockpile at the price the town purchased under the following conditions.

1. A culvert permit has been requested and approved.
2. The town has the approved culvert type and size in stock.
3. The installation must be only in the ROW of any of the roads in the Town of Cary.
4. The culvert is either used as a replacement of a culvert that is no longer allowing proper drainage, or will be installed as a new approved driveway entrance to a town road.

The Town of Cary does not regularly install new or replacement culverts. We are not selling culverts for general use. We will sell culverts to be used for driveway installation as a service for our property owners.

If we are performing ditching or drainage improvement in the immediate area and a culvert needs replacement, we will, if asked, install a replacement culvert the property owner has purchased, as we perform the ditch maintenance. We will not perform additional work, including improving the entrance or other work. Any materials required must be available, on site, this includes appropriate fill, or rock. The landowner is responsible for all materials to be available.
